# IN 2022, OVER 2,100+ CLIENTS WERE ASSISTED IN OVER 8,500+ CASES.










# SOCIAL MEDIA ORGANIZING

WITH ORGANIZERS MOBILIZING VIRTUALLY IN 2022, WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE'S ADVOCACY EFFORTS JOINED THEM.







IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE APA VOICE COALITION AND THE NEW YORK IMMIGRATION COALITION, WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE WAS ABLE TO ENGAGE IN VOTER OUTREACH AND EDUCATION. MOST OF OUR CIVIC ENGAGEMENT EVENTS CONSISTED OF PUBLIC OUTREACH IN THE FORM OF TABLING, SOCIAL MEDIA ORGANIZING, AND PHONE BANKING.

IN 2022, WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE WAS ABLE TO REGISTER NEW VOTERS AND HELP ANSWER QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS REGARDING THE ELECTIONS SUCH AS BALLOT INFORMATION, IMPORTANT VOTING DATES, ABSENTEE BALLOT, INFORMATION, AND OTHER CONCERNS. IN TOTAL, WE WERE ABLE TO REACH OUT TO OVER 80,000 COMMUNITY MEMBERS THROUGH EMAIL, TEXT, PHONE BANKING, AND TABLING.





WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE IS A PROUD PARTNER OF THE ASIAN AMERICAN FEDERATION HOPE AGAINST HATE INITIATIVE. THIS PAST YEAR, BY WORKING WITH SMALL BUSINESSES, WE ESTABLISHED OVER 50 SAFE ZONES THROUGHOUT WOODSIDE AND THE SURROUNDING NEIGHBORHOODS, DISPLAYING A SAFETY POSTER AND DISTRIBUTING SELF-DEFENSE AND ACTIVE BYSTANDER TRAINING BOOKLETS.

OUR ADDITIONAL PARTNERSHIPS INCLUDE THE COALITION FOR ASIAN AMERICAN FAMILIES (CACF) AND THE DIVERSE STREET INITIATIVE. THROUGH THESE TWO PARTNERSHIPS, WE ARE PROUD PARTICIPANTS IN THE AAPI COMMUNITY FUND THAT SUPPORTS HOLISTIC APPROACHES TO SAFETY THAT AIM TO PREVENT ANTI–ASIAN HATE AS WELL AS SERVE IMPACTED FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES.





WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE'S EDUCATION SERVICES HAVE BEEN MADE AVAILABLE TO 1,200 FAMILIES IN 2022.

WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE (WOTM) HAS PARTNERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (DYCD) TO PROVIDE SUPPORT AND ENGAGEMENT FOR YOUNG ADULTS THROUGH THE BEACON PROGRAM AND FREE AFTER-SCHOOL SERVICES THAT SERVE OVER 1,200 NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DOE) PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS THROUGH THE COMPASS AND EXPLORER PROGRAM FUNDED BY DYCD.





THE PROGRAMS ARE HELD AT PS 152, PS 11, PS 398Q, AND PS 361Q. WE ALSO RECENTLY EXPANDED OUR PROGRAMS TO A PRIVATE SCHOOL, ACADEMY OF THE CITY CHARTER SCHOOL. OUR PROGRAMS AID STUDENTS TO BUILD SKILLS THAT SUPPORT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND RAISE PARTICIPANTS' EXPECTATIONS AND CONFIDENCE AS ALL PROGRAM ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO ABIDE BY COMMON CORE STANDARDS.

THE SUMMER PROGRAM CONSISTED OF 6 WEEKS OF FREE EDUCATION AND ACTIVITY-BASED PROGRAMMING WITH THE GOAL TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT WHERE STUDENTS ARE WARMLY WELCOMED AND SUPPORTED IN THEIR EXPLORATION OF NEW SKILLS. DURING THE 6 WEEKS THE PARTICIPANTS ARE ABLE TO TAKE PART IN ENRICHMENT TRAINING AND COURSES SUCH AS COOKING, KNITTING, AND PIANO LESSONS.




# A BREAKDOWN OF HOW FAMILIES FROM OUR EDUCATION PROGRAM IDENTIFY THEMSELVES BY RACE:







# YOUTH ON THE MOVE

YOUTH ON THE MOVE HOSTED AND JOINED IN VARIOUS ACTIONS AND EVENTS THROUGHOUT 2022.





WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE'S YOUTH-LED VOLUNTEER INITIATIVE, YOUTH ON THE MOVE (YOTM), BASED IN WESTERN QUEENS, WAS CREATED TO CIVICALLY EMPOWER AND INCREASE COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION AMONG THE YOUTH IN QUEENS AND NEW YORK CITY.

YOUTH ON THE MOVE HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN NUMEROUS ACTIVITIES SUCH AS LOCAL COMMUNITY EVENTS, MUTUAL AID EFFORTS, ADVOCACY RALLIES, ANTI-GENTRIFICATION EFFORTS, LEGISLATIVE ACTIONS, FOOD INSECURITY INITIATIVES, VOLUNTEERING WITH LOCAL COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS AND LEADERS, AND HOLDING ELECTED OFFICIALS AND OUR LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABLE AND LISTENING TO THE VOICE AND CONCERNS OF THE YOUTH IN OUR COMMUNITY OF WESTERN QUEENS.

TO DATE, MEMBERS OF YOUTH ON THE MOVE DISTRIBUTED 6,000 FREE MEALS, 15,000 PPE AND HUNDREDS OF GIFTS AND TOYS TO FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNITY. WE HAVE OVER 145 REGISTERED YOUTH ON THE MOVE MEMBERS.





IN 2022, WOODSIDE ON THE MOVE BROUGHT IN COLLEGE STUDENTS FROM A VARIETY OF COLLEGES THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES.


